

them; but that water shall be allowed to flow into this ditch at such times, only, as said North Branch of Brush Creek fails to supply the water herein decreed to said ditches and then, only in such quantity as, in addition to the amount then obtainable for said ditches from said North Brush Creek, will furnish to said ditches, and each of them, the quantity and quantities of water hereinbefore decreed to them.

No. 148—The Hill Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No's 127 and 279, which are also Howard Creek priorities No's 4 and 13; that said ditch is owned by Catherine Pickens; that said ditch takes its water from the North side of said Howard Creek in the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, Tp. 48 N, R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirteen acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Pickens, under and by virtue of priority No. 127, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of ten acres of land; and that said cubic foot of water per second of time be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 279 for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of three acres of additional land.

No. 149—The Kelso Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 128, 227 and 303; that said ditch is owned by George W. Kelso; that said ditch takes its water from the North side of said Arkansas River
