

West, 332 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seventy (70) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, for the use and benefit of said Witcher, under and by virtue of said priority No. 139, one and thirty-one hundredths (1.31) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, for the use of said Witcher, under and by virtue of priority No. 233, the additional amount of five hundred and twenty-six hundredths (0.526) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 165—The Riggs Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 139, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 40; that said ditch is owned by Julia S. Riggs; that the headgate of said ditch is on the North side of said Four Mile Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 139, continually during the irrigation season, two (2) cubic feet of water per second of time, or such less amount as is sufficient to irrigate said 50 acres of land.

No. 166—The Watson Ditch No. 2

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 139 and 156, which are also Four Mile Creek priorities No's 40 and 48; that said priority No. 139 is the 7th priority on the upper part of said Four Mile Creek, and the 4th priority above the mouth of West Four Mile Creek; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on the West side of said Four Mile Creek,
