

ority No. 46; that said ditch takes its supply of water from West Four Mile Creek, and is entitled to the 11th priority on said West Four Mile Creek; that said ditch is not subject to priorities of ditches taken out above the mouth of said West Four Mile Creek; that said ditch is owned by John O'Brien and Charles Kestle, each of whom own an undivided one half interest therein; that the headgate of said ditch is on the South side of said West Four Mile creek, in the County of Park; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 12 acres of land owned by said Kestle and eight acres owned by said O'Brien; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 152, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as shall be sufficient for the irrigation of said twenty acres of land; and that said John O'Brien shall at any and all times hereafter have and be entitled to forty-one thousand one hundred and twenty-eight hundred thousandths (0.41128) of the whole amount of water herein decreed to said ditch, and that said Charles Kestle shall, at any and all times hereafter, have and be entitled to fifty-eight thousand six hundred and thirty-six hundred thousandths (0.58636) of the whole amount of water herein decreed to said ditch,

#### No. 178—The John Cox Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 152 and 243, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 30 and 68, Brush Creek priorities No's 9 & 28, South Brush Creek No's. 4 & 10; that said ditch is owned by John Adams; that said ditch takes its water from South Brush Creek,
