

riority No. 153, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 31, Lake Creek priority No. 5 and Short Creek priority No. 1; that said ditch is owned by Thomas Balman; that said ditch takes water from Lake Creek and Short Creek; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the South East side of said Lake Creek at a point to find which start from the corner common to sections 3 and 4, Tp. 46, Range 12 East and sections 33 and 34 Tp. 47 North, Range 12 East, run thence North 66 degrees and 25 minutes West, 7 chains and 60 links, thence North 83 degrees and 55 minutes West 2 chains and 45 links to headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred and sixty (160) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, from said Lake Creek, for the use and benefit of said Balman, under and by virtue of said priority No. 153, four and two tenths (4.2) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that when the said amount herein decreed to said ditch cannot be obtained from said Lake Creek then, and at such times, so much water shall be allowed to flow into said ditch from said Short Creek and under and by virtue of said priority No. 153 as will, in addition to the amount then obtainable for said ditch from said Lake Creek, furnish said ditch with the full amount of water herein decreed to it.

No. 181—The Meadow Ditch, Hall's.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 153, which is also Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek priority No. 3; that said ditch is owned by George A. Hall; that said ditch takes its water from the South side of the North Prong of the Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek; that said
