

ditch is used for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; that the said ditch is 18 inches wide, 9 inches deep and has a grade of one inch to the rod; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Hall, under and by virtue of priority No. 153, so much water as said ditch will carry for as many periods in each year, of three (3) days each as shall be necessary to irrigate said five acres of land. Provided, however, that as between the said George A. Hall and Daniel Hall, the said George A. Hall shall have all the water, during the irrigation season, which shall flow down the North prong of the middle fork of Tallahassee Creek, and shall have the sole use thereof in the said The Meadow Ditch, for and during the time beginning at the hour of six o'clock in the morning of each and every Friday, and ending at the hour of twelve o'clock, noon, on each and every Sunday for all future time, without any hindrance or interference on the part of said Daniel Hall.

No. 182—The Second Perry Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 153, which is also Beaver Creek priority No. 29; that the owner thereof is Leverett S. Perry; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of lands; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Perry, under and by virtue of said priority No. 153, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of one (1) acre of land lying above the junction of this ditch with The Upper Perry Ditch and for the irrigation of one half of thirty-two acres lying below said junction.
