

### No. 183—The Tremayne Brothers Ditch No. 3.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 154, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 47; that said ditch takes its supply of water from West Four Mile Creek, and is entitled to the 12th priority on said West Four Mile Creek; that on account of the location of the mouth of said West Four Mile Creek this ditch is not subject to Four Mile Creek priorities No's 31, 32, 38, and 40; that said ditch is owned by Richard Tremayne and John Tremayne; that the headgate of said ditch is on the South side of said creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 154, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as shall be sufficient to irrigate said ten acres of land.

### No. 184—The Jim Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 155, and 202, which are also main Tallahassee Creek priorities No's 5 and 9; that Kate Gorman is the owner of an undivided five sevenths (5-7) of said ditch; that said ditch takes its water from the North East side of main Tallahassee Creek, and its headgate is located 150 yards East from the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 9, Tp. 17 S, R 73 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifteen acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Kate Gorman, under and by virtue of said priority No. 155, one and one half cubic feet of water per second of time, for as many periods in each year,
