

of one and one half days each, as is necessary for the irrigation of three (3) acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Kate Gorman, under and by virtue of said priority No. 202, one and one half cubic feet of water per second of time, for as many additional periods in each year, of six (6) days each, as is necessary for the irrigation of twelve (12) acres of land; but not more than one and one half cubic feet of water shall be allowed to flow in said ditch at any one time. Provided, however, that as between the said The Jim Ditch and the Gardner Ditch No. 1, The Gardner Ditch No. 2, The Gardner Ditch No. 3, and The Gardner Ditch No. 4, the said The Jim Ditch shall have the exclusive right and privilege to use and divert all of the waters flowing in in said main (or North Fork) Tallahassee Creek, for the purpose of irrigation, two days in each and every week commencing at 6 P. M on Sunday of each and every week.

No. 185—The Chivvis Ditch No. 3.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 155, which is also main Tallahassee Creek priority No. 5; that said ditch is owned by Alfred V. Chivvis; that said ditch takes its water from Tallahassee Creek, and its headgate is situate N. 84 degrees and 25 minutes West, 2375 feet, from the East quarter corner of Sec. 9, Tp. 17 S, R 73 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seven (7) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Chivvis, under and by virtue of said priority No. 155, one and one half cubic feet of water per second of time for as many periods, in each year, of three and one half
