

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 156 and 356, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 32 and 98, Brush Creek priorities No's 10 and 40, and South Brush Creek priorities No's 5 and 16; that said ditch is owned by John Kick and Michael O'Leary, each of whom owns an undivided one half thereof; that said ditch takes water from said South Brush Creek, and its head-gate is situate on the East bank of said creek at a point North 35 degrees East, 510 feet, from the South West corner of the South East quarter of the South West quarter of Sec. 14, Tp. 46, Range 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of two hundred (200) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, for the use of said owners of said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 156, four and two tenths (4.2) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owners of said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 356, constantly, the further quantity of one and five hundredths (1.05) cubic feet of water per second of time.
