

water from said Brush Creek, and its headgate is located on the East side thereof at a point to be found thus from the section corner of Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East run North 61 degrees East, 1220 feet, thence N. 58 degrees East, 432 feet, thence N. 52 degrees and 30 minutes East, 80 feet to head of ditch; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of eighty-seven (87) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Balman, under and by virtue of said priority No. 156, constantly, one and seven hundred and sixty-three thousandths (1.763) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Balman, under and by virtue of said priority No. 226, constantly, the further quantity of fifty-two hundredths (0.52) of one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 190—The Mermod Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 157, which is also Cottonwood Creek priority No. 6; that the Poncha Park Land and Cattle Company is the owner of said ditch; that its headgate is located on the North side of said creek at a point North 58 degrees and 33 minutes West, and is distant 990 feet from the quarter section corner on the West line of said section 20, Tp. 51 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said company, under and by virtue of said priority No. 157, two and one half cubic feet of water per second of time for as many periods, not exceeding four, of
