

water per second of time for as many periods in each year of the five (5) days each as shall be sufficient to irrigate ten (10) acres of land; and that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 203, for the use and benefit of said Crampton, for such additional periods in each year of three (3) days each as shall be sufficient for the irrigation of six (6) acres of land.

No. 197—The Haggart Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 160, which is also Cottonwood Creek priority No. 7; that said ditch is owned by Ira Chivvis; that said ditch takes its water from Short Creek, a tributary of Cottonwood Creek, and its headgate is located on the North side of said creek at a point N. 75 degrees and 30 minutes West, 1825 feet, from the quarter corner on the East line of Sec. 30, Tp. 16 S, R 73 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Chivvis, under and by virtue of said priority No. 160, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for as many periods, not exceeding three, of two days each, as shall be necessary to irrigate two acres of land; and that said amount of water be further allowed to flow in said ditch for as many additional periods, not exceeding five, of three and one half days each, as shall be sufficient to irrigate eight acres of land.

No. 198—The Minton Ditch.

That said ditch takes its water from Beaver Creek; that said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priori-
