

ties No's 162 and 285, which are also Beaver Creek priorities No's 30 and 45; that said ditch is owned by William E. Banta and C. W. Banta, each of whom owns an undivided one half thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owners thereof, constantly during the irrigation season eight tenths (0.8) of one cubic foot of water per second of time; and that said ditch is entitled to three tenths (0.3) of said water under and by virtue of priority No. 162, and to seven tenths (0.7) of said water under and by virtue priority No. 285.

No. 199—The Stout Ditch No. 4.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 165 and 294, which are also Stout Creek priorities No's 6 and 15; that said ditch is owned by Malissie E. Stout; that said ditch takes its water from Stout Creek, and that its head is situate on the South side of said creek in the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14, Tp. 48, N, R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seventy-five (75) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 165, constantly during the irrigation season, two and eight tenths (2.8) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 294, constantly during the irrigation season, under and by virtue of priority No. 294, the further quantity of two tenths (0.2) of one cubic foot of water per second of time.
