

under and by virtue of said priority No. 210, the further quantity of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land.

No. 202—The Cottonwood Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 168 and 349, which are also West Creek priorities No's 2 and 4; that said ditch is owned by Hattie E. Latham; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the North side of said West Creek at a point S. 17 degrees E, 80 poles from the N, W corner of Sec. 11, Tp. 48 N, R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty (40) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Latham, one and six tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that of said amount three eighths shall be allowed to flow into said ditch under and by virtue of priority No. 168 and five eighths under and by virtue of said priority No. 349; that the said amount of water shall be allowed to flow constantly in said ditch during the irrigation season.

No. 203—The Jack Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 169, which is also Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek priority No. 4; that said ditch is owned by George Fear; that said ditch takes its water from an un-named gulch between the North and South forks of the middle branch of Tallahassee Creek at a point in the N, W, $\frac{3}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{3}{4}$ of Sec. 20, Tp. 17 S, R 73 West; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of said Fear, under and by virtue of priority No. 169, so much
