

that it is used for the irrigation of twenty-five acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said company, under and by virtue of said priority No. 171, three and one half cubic feet of water per second of time for as many periods, not exceeding four, of ten days each as may be sufficient to irrigate said 25 acres of land.

#### No. 206—The Spring Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 171, which is also Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek priority, No. 6; that George Fear is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch takes its water from the South side of the South branch of the middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of six (6) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Fear, under and by virtue of said priority No. 171, one and one half cubic feet of water per second of time for as many periods in each year, of four days each, as shall be sufficient to irrigate said six acres of land. Provided, however, that as between the said The Spring Ditch and the ditches of the said Daniel Hall: The Pioneer Ditch, The Potato Patch Ditch, The Morning Star Ditch and The Dick Creek Ditch, the said The Spring Ditch shall have the prior right to the use of all the water flowing in, and to flow in, the middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek above and at the junction of the North and South Forks thereof, at the natural and unobstructed flow therein, for two days of twenty-four hours each, out of each and every five days; and that when the water shall fail, through natural causes, as to flow in said creek in
