

which shall flow down the North prong of the middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek and shall have the sole use thereof in his said The Arch North Ditch for and during the time beginning at the hour of 6 o'clock in the morning of each and every Friday, and ending at the hour of 12 o'clock, noon, on each and every Sunday, for all future time.

#### No. 213—The Spring Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 173, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 53; that William Grose is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch takes its water from West Four Mile Creek and is not subject to any priority on Four Mile Creek above the mouth of said West Four Mile Creek; that said priority No. 173 is the 14th priority on said West Four Mile Creek; that said ditch is not subject to priorities No's 31, 32, 38, 40, 47, 48 and 50; that the headgate of said ditch is on the North side of said West Four Mile Creek, in the County of El Paso; that ten (10) acres of land are irrigated from said ditch; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Grose, under and by virtue of said priority No. 173, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of said ten acres of land.

#### No. 214—The Black Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 173 and 278, which are also Cottonwood Creek priorities No's 9 and 18; that said ditch is owned by Walter J. Black; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the North side of
