#### No. 216—The Koch Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 175, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 38, Brush Creek priority No. 14 and South Brush Creek priority No. 6; that said ditch is owned by Fred Koch and Conrad Koch, each of whom owns an undivided one half thereof; that the head-gate of said ditch is situate on the South bank of said South Brush Creek at a point N. 76 degrees W, 1200 feet from the S. E. corner of Sec. 14, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred and eighty (180) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owners of said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 175, constantly, four and seven tenths (4.7) cubic feet of water per second of time.

#### No. 217—The Lockhart & Dissmore Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 175, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 38, Brush Creek priority No. 14 and North Brush Creek priority No. 6; that said ditch is owned by N. B. Dissmore; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the North bank of North Brush Creek, at a point whence the N. E. corner of Sec. 14, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East bears N 5 degrees and 36 minutes East, 1554 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-five (35) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the
