

use of said Lissmore, under and by virtue of priority No. 175, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient to irrigate said thirty-five acres of land.

No. 218—The Mermod Ditch No. 3.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 176, which is also Cottonwood Creek priority No. 11; that said ditch is owned by The Poncha Park Land and Cattle Company, that the head of said ditch is located on the West side of Little Cottonwood Creek at a point North 80 degrees and 19 minutes West, distant 2050 feet, from the South East corner of Sec. 21, Tp. 51 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of said company, under and by virtue of priority No. 176, four cubic feet of water per second of time for as many periods not exceeding five, of ten days each, as may be necessary for the irrigation of said 50 acres of land.

No. 219—The Cox Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 177, which is also main Tallahassee Creek priority No. 7; that said ditch is owned by Fredric A. Reynolds; that said ditch takes its water from Tallahassee Creek at a point N. 85 degrees and 48 minutes W, distant 2517 feet, from the quarter section corner on the East line of section 25, Tp. 17 S, R 73 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 9 acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Reynolds, under and by virtue of priority No. 177, one and one
