

fourth cubic feet of water per second of time for as many periods in each year of five days each, as is necessary for the irrigation of said 9 acres of land.

No. 220—The Sikes, Cypert and Chatham Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 178, 307, and 317, which are also Hardscrabble Creek priorities No's 33, 48 and 64; that the owners of said ditch are August Hundt and Paul F. Zastro, each of whom owns an undivided one eighth thereof, and S. N. Cypert, George W. Sikes, and William P. Sikes, each of whom owns an undivided one quarter thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of sixty-five (65) acres owned by Caroline Sikes, ninety-nine (99) acres owned by August Hundt and Paul F. Zastro, fifty acres owned by S. N. Cypert, and 62 acres owned by George W. Sikes; that said ditch uses water from said Hardscrabble Creek and that its headgate is located on the East side thereof at a point whence the N. E. corner of section 2, Tp. 21 S, R 69 West, in Custer County, bears N. 52 degrees and 45 minutes East, distant 3560 feet; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the irrigation of the aforesaid lands and for the benefit of the owners above named and of their heirs and assigns, under and by virtue of said priority No. 178, two and seventy-three hundred and seventy-five ten thousandths (2.7375) cubic feet of water per second of time, or so much thereof as shall be sufficient for the irrigation of 65 acres owned by said Caroline Sikes, seventy acres owned by said Hundt and Zastro, 44 acres owned by S. N. Cypert, and 40 acres owned by said G. W. Sikes, 219 acres in all; and that there be fur-
