

ther allowed to flow into said ditch the further amount of two hundred and seventy-five thousandths (0.275) of one cubic foot of water per second of time, or so much thereof as shall be necessary for the irrigation of twenty-two acres owned by said G. W. Sikes, which last mentioned amount of water shall be so allowed to flow for the use and benefit of said George W. Sikes and his heirs and assigns, under and by virtue of priority No. 307; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said August Hundt and Paul F. Zastro and S. N. Cypert and their heirs and assigns, and under and by virtue of said priority No. 317, the further quantity of forty-three hundred and seventy-five ten thousandths (0.4375) of one cubic foot of water per second of time, or so much thereof as shall be necessary for the irrigation of 29 acres owned by said Hundt and Zastro, 6 acres owned by said Cypert; the total amount of water decreed to this ditch under all of its priorities being three and forty-five hundredths (3.45) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 221—The Howard Ditch.

That said ditch takes its water from Howard Creek; that said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 178, which is also Howard Creek priority No. 6; that said ditch is owned by Catharine Pickens; that the headgate of said ditch is situate in the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, Tp. 48 N, R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifteen (15) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the said owners thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 178, one cubic foot of water per second of
