

constantly during the irrigation season, the further quantity of eight tenths (0.8) of one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 227—The Vipond Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 186 and 374, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 42 and 104; that said ditch is owned by Thomas Vipond; that said ditch takes its water from the East side of Texas Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-one acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Vipond, under and by virtue of priority No. 186, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of three (3) acres of land; and that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 374, for such additional time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of—18—acres of additional land.

No. 228—The Gross & Witcher Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 187, 130 and 279, which are also Barnard Creek priorities No's 3, 4, and 5; that said ditch is owned by Taliaferro Witcher; that the head-gate of said ditch is located in lot three in fractional section 18. Tp. 48 N., R. 12 E., and is 121 feet East of the N. W. corner of said lot three; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty-five (45) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Witcher, under and by virtue of said priority No. 130, one cubic foot of water per
