

second of time, for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 187 for such additional times as is necessary for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of additional land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under priority No. 279 for the use of said Witcher, the further quantity of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of still additional land.

No. 229—The Meadow Ditch, Fear's.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 187, which is also Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek priority No. 8; that said ditch is owned by George Fear; that said ditch is taken out of and from the North side of the South branch of the middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-five acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Fear, under and by virtue of priority No. 187, so much water as a ditch two feet wide, 7 inches deep and having a grade of one inch to the rod, will carry for as many periods in each year, of 17 days each, as shall be sufficient to irrigate said 35 acres of land. Provided, however, that as between the said The Meadow Ditch and the ditches of Daniel Hall herein decreed on the said The Meadow Ditch shall have the prior right to the use of all the water flowing in, and to flow in, the middle fork of Tallahassee Creek above and at the junction of the North and South branches thereof, at the natural and unobstructed
