

Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek and shall have the sole use thereof in his The Arch South Ditch for and during the time beginning at the hour of 6 o'clock in the morning of each and every Friday, and ending at the hour of 12 o'clock, noon, on each and every Sunday, for all future time.

No. 231—The Dick Creek Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 187, which is also Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek priority No. 8; that said ditch is owned by Daniel Hall; that said ditch takes its water from the South side of the North Branch of the Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek, above the junction of the North branch with the South branch of said Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land and, in connection with The Pioneer Ditch of said Daniel Hall, for the irrigation of the fifty acres irrigated from The Pioneer Ditch; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 187, so much water as a ditch one foot wide at the bottom, 18 inches wide at the top, 11 inches deep, and having a grade of one half inch to the rod, will carry for as many periods in each year, of two and one half days each, as is necessary to irrigate said five acres of land, and, that when on the days and times herein decreed that the Pioneer Ditch may take and use water from the South Prong of the Middle Fork of Tallahassee Creek, the amount decreed to said ditch cannot be obtained from said South Prong, there shall be allowed to run into said The Dick Creek Ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 187, so much water, in addition to the amount which can be had
