

R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of eighty (80) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Jackson, under and by virtue of said priority No. 190 constantly during the irrigation season, three and two tenths (3.2) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 235—The Allen Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 190 and 275, which are also Cherry Creek priorities No's 1 and 2; that said ditch is owned by A W. Alexander; that said ditch takes its water from Cherry Creek and that its head-gate is situate at a point 84 rods East of the quarter section corner between sections 14 and 15 in T. 48 N, R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of eighty (80) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 190, constantly during the irrigation season one and two tenths (1.2) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 275, the further quantity of two (2) cubic feet of water per second of time, which amount shall also be allowed to run constantly in said ditch during the irrigation season.

No. 236—Nichols' Extension of the Allen Extension of Breece's North Side Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 191, which is also Four Mile Creek (tributary to said Hardscrabble Creek) priority No. 4;
