

said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-five (25) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Witcher, under and by virtue of priority No. 196, constantly during the irrigation season, one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 239—The Mow Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 197, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 44, and Lake Creek priority No. 6; that said ditch is owned by John O. Mow and Sidney B. McClurken; that said ditch takes its water from said Lake Creek, and its headgate is situate at a point 20 rods North of the South center of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ninety (90) acres owned by said McClurken and eighty (80) acres owned by said Mow; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 197, constantly during the irrigation season, four and four hundred and seventy-two thousandths (4.472) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 240—The Island Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 200, which is also Beaver Creek priority No. 37; that said ditch is owned by Leverett S. Perry; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seven and one half acres ($7\frac{1}{2}$ acres) of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Perry, under and by virtue of said priority No. 200, one cubic foot of water per
