

second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient to irrigate said seven and one half acres.

No. 241—The Gorman Ditch No. 3.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 201, which is main or North Fork of Tallahassee Creek priority No. 8; that said ditch is owned by Kate Gorman; that said ditch is taken out of and from the South West side of said Tallahassee Creek, in the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9, Tp. 17 S, R 73 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty (30) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 201, two cubic feet of water per second of time for as many periods, in each year, of fifteen days each, as shall be necessary to irrigate said thirty acres of land.

Provided, however, that as between this ditch and the Gardner Ditch No. 1, The Gardner Ditch No. 2, The Gardner Ditch No. 3 and The Gardner Ditch No. 4, the said The Gorman Ditch No. 3 shall have the exclusive right and privilege to use and divert all of the waters flowing in said main (or North Fork) of Tallahassee Creek, for the purpose of irrigation, two days in each and every week, commencing at 6 p. m on Sunday of each and every week to and until 6 p. m on Tuesday of each and every week.

No. 242—The John Duckett Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 202, 267, 323, and 394, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 46, 75, 87, and 113, and
