

Lake Creek priorities Nos 8, 9, 11, and 14; that said ditch is owned by Alfred Hatley and Charles E. Lewis, each of whom owns an undivided one half thereof; that said ditch takes its water from the North branch of Lake Creek; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on the South East side of said Creek, in Sec. 7, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred and ninety (190) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch under priority No. 202, constantly during the irrigation season for the irrigation of 70 acres owned by Lewis and 80 acres owned by Hatley, three and ninety-four hundredths (3.94) cubic feet of water per second of time; that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, for the use of said Lewis, under and by virtue of priority No. 267 the additional amount of two hundred and sixty-three thousandths (0.263) of one cubic foot of water per second of time; that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the irrigation of ten acres owned by said Lewis, under and by virtue of priority No. 323, constantly during the irrigation season, the further quantity of two hundred and sixty-three thousandths (0.263) of one cubic foot of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the irrigation of 20 acres owned by said Hatley, constantly during the irrigation season, under and by virtue of priority No. 394, the further quantity of five hundred and twenty-six thousandths (0.526) of one cubic foot of water per second of time.
