

said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 203, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of two acres of land; that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 273, for such additional time and times as is sufficient to irrigate three acres of land; and that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 391 for such still additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of two acres of land.

No. 248—The Lewis Lower Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 203, which is also Hardscrabble Creek priority No. 37; that George W. Funderburk and Mrs. N. A. Dickson own three fourths of said ditch, Jacob W. Brunner owns one sixth, and David Westheffer owns one twelfth thereof; that said ditch is used to irrigate twenty-two acres owned by said Funderburk and Dickson, seven (7) acres owned by said Westheffer, and is used to irrigate a garden owned by said Westheffer; that said ditch takes water from the North fork of Hardscrabble Creek and its headgate is located on the West or North side thereof; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Funderburk, Dickson and Westheffer, under and by virtue of said priority No. 203, one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time for three days out of every four days, or for such less time as shall be sufficient for the irrigation of said twenty-nine (29) acres of land above mentioned as owned and irrigated by said last named owners.
