

### No. 250—The W. R. Voris Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No's 205 and 306, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 48 and 85, Brush Creek priorities No's 16 and 33; that said ditch is owned by Thomas Balman; that said ditch takes its water from Brush Creek, and its headgate is situate on the North side of said creek at a point to find which, commence at the section corner common to sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, Tp. 46 N, R 12 E, run thence S. 11 degrees E, 32 links, thence N. 34 degrees E 9 chains, thence E, 11 chains, thence S. 1 degree and 39 minutes E, three and one half chains, thence S. 22 degrees and 15 minutes E 1 chain, thence S, 33 degrees E, 30 links to headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of two hundred and eighty acres (280 acres) of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, for the use and benefit of said Balman under and by virtue of said priority No. 306, seven and three hundred and sixty-eight thousandths (7,368) cubic feet of water per second of time.

The evidence does not disclose how much land was irrigated prior to 1884, hence can decree no rights under priority No. 205.

### No. 251—The Sawmill Voris Ditch.
