

ditch is owned by J. J. Beach; that said ditch takes its water from the North branch of Brush Creek at a point S. 26 degrees and 45 minutes W, 460 feet, from the N. E. corner of the N. W.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the S. E.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of Sec. 22, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of eighty (80) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, under and by virtue of said priority No. 206, two and one tenth (2.1) cubic feet of water per second of time.

#### No. 252—The Marmaduke Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No.s 207, and 382, which are also Stout Creek priorities No's 9 and 19; that said ditch is owned by Benjamin F. Wells and Charles W. Wells; that said ditch takes its water from said Stout Creek and its headgate is located on the South side of said creek in the N. W.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the S. W.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of Sec. 23, Tp. 48 N, R 11 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifteen acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owners thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 207, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of four (4) acres of land; and that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owners, under and by virtue of said priority No. 382, for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of eleven acres of land.

#### No. 253—The Mosier Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 208, which is also Mosier Creek priority
