

No. 1, which is the only priority on said creek; that said ditch is owned by Charles Kaess; that its headgate is situate on the North side of Mosier Creek in the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, Tp. 47 N, R 11 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five acres of land and to assist in the irrigation of twenty-four acres under The Little Cottonwood Ditch; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Kaess, under and by virtue of said priority No. 208, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said five (5) acres of land; and as this ditch is used, also, to assist in the irrigation of the twenty-four acres of land under the Little Cottonwood Ditch it is hereby decreed that the quantity of water hereinafter decreed to said Little Cottonwood Creek Ditch may be allowed to flow into and through this ditch, or part thereof may be allowed to flow in this ditch and part in said Little Cottonwood Ditch, as the owner of said ditches may choose, the same to so flow under and by virtue of priority No. 230.

No. 254—The Howard Ditch No. 3.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 211, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 50; that said ditch is owned by John Howard; that said ditch takes water from said Texas Creek and its headgate is situated on the West side of said creek at a point to find which commence at the quarter section corner between sections 1 and 2, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East, run thence North 4 degrees E, 15 links, thence N. 65 degrees and 30 minutes W, 8 chains and 70 links to headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twelve (12) acres of land;
