

and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 211, one (1) cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of said 12 acres of land.

No. 255—The Corral Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 212, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 51, and Brush Creek priority No. 18; that said ditch is owned by Rebecca Ernwein; that the head-gate of said ditch is situate on the South side of Brush Creek in the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14, Tp. 46 N, R. 12; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 212, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said ten acres of land.

No. 256—The Pioneer South Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 213, which is also main or North Fork of Tallahassee Creek priority No. 11; that said ditch is owned by Joseph Hall; that said ditch takes its water from Main (or North Fork of) Tallahassee Creek and its headgate is located on the South side of said creek as near as may be 30 rods N. and 10 rods W, from the S. E. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7, Tp. 17 S, R. 73 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of four (4) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said
