

59 on said Four Mile Creek; that Thomas Grose is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch takes water from West Four Mile Creek, and its headgate is situate on the South side of said creek in the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5, Tp. 15 S, R 71 West, in the County of Park; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 221, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of the land actually irrigated from said ditch.

No. 260—The Graham Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority Nos 222 and 334, that said ditch is owned by James Graham; that said ditch takes its water from said Arkansas River, and its headgate is situate on the South side of said river at a point found by commencing at the joint corner of sections 7, 12, 13 and 18 S, R 69 West thence N. 4 degrees East, 2700 feet that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of land; that said ditch was taken out in 1880 and is entitled to priority No. 222, but the testimony fails to show how much land was irrigated from said ditch prior to March 20th, 1886; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the said owner thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 334, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said twenty acres of land.

No. 261—The Thomas Balman Ditch No. 4.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 222 which is also Texas Creek priority
