**No. 263—The John Spalding Ditch No. 1.**

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 224, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 5; that said ditch is owned by John Spalding that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seven and one half acres (7.5) of land; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the East side of said creek at a point S. 42 degrees and 30 minutes E, 153 feet from the N. W corner of the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 20, Tp. 21 S, R 70 West; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 224, forty-one hundredths (0.41) of one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of seven and one half acres of land.

**No. 264—The Howard Ditch No. 2.**

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 226, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 57; that said ditch is owned by John Howard; that said ditch takes its water from said Texas Creek, and its headgate is located at a point to find which commence at the quarter corner between sections 1 and 2 in Tp. 46 N, R 12 East, run thence S. 51 degrees E, 5 chains, to headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the said owner, under and by
