

virtue of said priority No. 226, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of said five acres of land.

No. 265—The Reed Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No.s 226 and 282 which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 57 and 81; that said ditch is owned by H. G. Reed; that said ditch takes its water from Texas Creek; that the headgate of said ditch is situate at a point to find which begin at the common corner of sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, Tp. 21 S, R 73 W, running thence N. 74 degrees and 30 minutes W, 16.50 chains, thence N. 61 degrees and 15 minutes W, 9.3 chains, thence N. 75 degrees and 15 minutes W, 3 chains to headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty-eight (48) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 226, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of eight (8) acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Reed, under and by virtue of priority No. 282, constantly, the further quantity of one and five hundredths (1.05) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 266—The Lucas Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 226, 306, 344 and 376, which are also Four Mile priorities No's 62, 68, 78 and 84; that said ditch is owned by Dana Lawrence and Aaron Ripley, each of whom owns one half thereof, that
