

the head of said ditch is on the West side of said Four Mile Creek, in the N. E. $\frac{3}{4}$ of the N. W. $\frac{3}{4}$ of Sec. 16, Tp. 17 S, R 70 West, and is 20 feet N, and 19 rods E, of the S. W corner of said tract; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-six (26) acres of land; that for the use and benefit of the said owners of said ditch there shall be allowed to flow into said ditch for such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of said 26 acres of land, which shall be allowed to the several priorities as follows: under and by virtue of priority No. 226 said amount of water shall be allowed to flow for such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of ten and one half acres of land, under and by virtue of priority No. 306, said water shall be allowed to flow for such additional time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of nine (9) acres of land, under and by virtue of priority No. 344 said quantity of water shall be allowed to flow in said ditch for such further time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of four (4) acres of land, and under and by virtue of priority No. 376, said quantity of water shall be further allowed to flow into said ditch for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of two and one half acres of land.

No. 267—The Waggoner Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 227, which is also Stout Creek priority No. 10; that said ditch is owned by Isabelle N. Veal and Frank Crozier, each of whom own an undivided one half thereof; that said ditch takes its water from Stout Creek, and its headgate is situate on the West bank of said creek at a point in Sec. 23, Tp.
