

48 N, R to East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-two acres owned by said Veal and fifteen acres owned by said Crozier; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, one and forty-eight hundredths (1.48) cubic feet of water per second of time, for the use of said owners, and under and by virtue of said priority No. 227.

No. 268—The Pioneer North Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 228 and 326, which are also main Tallahassee Creek priorities No's 13 and 18; said ditch is owned by Joseph Hall; that the head of said ditch is located on the North side of said Tallahassee Creek; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 228, two cubic feet of water per second of time for as many periods in each year, of six days each, as shall be necessary for the irrigation of nineteen (19) acres of land; and that said amount of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 326, for such additional periods in each year, of one day each, as shall be sufficient for the irrigation of one additional acre of land.

No. 269—The Caughman Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 229, and 327, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 58 and 91; that said ditch is owned by Seaborn Caughman; that said ditch takes water from said Texas Creek, and its head is situate on the East side of said creek at a point to find which begin at the common corner of sections 20,
