

21, 28, and 29, Tp. 21 S, R 73 West; run thence N. 56 degrees E, 10.5 chains, thence N. 58 degrees and 15 minutes E, 8.4 chains to said headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-two acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 229, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient to irrigate twenty acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 327, said quantity of water for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of twelve acres of land.

No. 270—The Little Cottonwood Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 230, which is also Cottonwood Creek, tributary to Arkansas River, priority No. 3; that said ditch is owned by Charles Kaess; that said ditch takes water from said Little Cottonwood Creek, and is the only ditch which does, and its head is situate on the East side of said creek in the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 35, Tp. 47 N, R 11 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-four acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for the use of the said owner of said ditch, and under and by virtue of said priority No. 230.

No. 271—The Spruce Grove Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 231, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 59, Brush Creek priority No. 22, and South
