

Brush Creek priority No. 7; that said ditch is owned by Jacob B. Miller; that said ditch takes water from the South branch of Brush Creek at a point on the North bank thereof whence the N. $\frac{3}{4}$ corner of Sec. 23, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East bears N. 24 degrees and 50 minutes E, 1332 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twelve (12) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 231, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of said twelve acres of land.

No. 272—The Howard Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 232, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 60; that said ditch is owned by John Howard; that said ditch takes water from said Texas Creek, and its headgate is situate on the East side of said creek at a point to find which commence at the quarter section corner between sections 1 and 2, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East, run thence N. 22 degrees and 30 minutes West, ten chains and 35 links, thence N. 47 degrees and 45 minutes West, 2 chains, thence N. 16 degrees West, 4 chains to headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seven (7) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 232, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said seven acres of land.
