No. 277—The Fellows Ditch.

N. Fellows; that the head of said ditch is located on the S. E. bank of the South branch of Brush Creek at a point whence the N. $\frac{3}{4}$ corner of Sec. 27, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East, bears N. 71 degrees and 12 minutes West, 499 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 235, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said ten acres of land.

No. 278—The McClurken Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 236, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 65, Brush Creek priority No. 25, and South Brush Creek priority No. 9; that said ditch is owned by Sidney B. McClurken; that the head of said ditch is situate on the South East bank of South Brush Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty (40) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, for the use of said owner, under
