

and by virtue of said priority No. 236, one and five hundredths (1.05) cubic feet of water per second of time.

#### No. 279—The Harry Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 237, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 64; that said ditch takes its water from West Four Mile Creek; that it has the 18th priority on said West Four Mile Creek, and is not subject to Four Mile Creek priorities No's 31, 32, 38, 40, 44, 48, 49, 51, 54, 55, 58 and 59; that Thomas Grose is the owner of said ditch; that the head of said ditch is on the North side of said West Four Mile Creek in the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 5, Tp. 15 S, R 71, in the County of Park; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 237, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of the land actually irrigated from said ditch, which said lands do not exceed, in amount, twenty-five acres.

#### No. 280—The Gove Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 238, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 66, Brush Creek priority No. 26, and Koch's Spring Branch of Brush Creek priority No. 2; that said ditch is owned by Asa S. Gove; that the head-gate of said ditch is located at a point to find which commence at the quarter section corner between sections 1 and 12 in Tp. 46 N, R 12 East, run thence N. 81 degrees and 45 minutes E, 8 chains and 80
