

be sufficient for the irrigation of said ten acres of land.

No. 282—The Nathan Bragg Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 242, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 7; that said ditch is owned by Martin McCormick; that said ditch takes its water from Oak Creek and its head is located on the East side of said creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of eight (8) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 242, three fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$) of one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said eight acres of land.

No. 283—The Orange White Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 243, that said ditch is owned by The Florence and Refining Company; that said ditch takes its water from the Arkansas River and its headgate is situate on the South bank of said river at a point within the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 15, Tp. 19 S, R 69 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 243, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said 20 acres of land.
