

bic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of land.

No. 289—The Somerville Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 248, which is also main Tallahassee Creek priority No. 15; that said ditch is owned by A. C. Somerville; that said ditch takes its water from said Tallahassee Creek at a point on the West side thereof N. 75 degrees E, 1360 feet from the N. W. corner of Sec. 31, Tp. 17 S, R 72 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of nine (9) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 248, two cubic feet of water per second of time, for as many periods in each year, of four (4) days each as is sufficient for the irrigation of nine (9) acres of land.

No. 290—The Craine Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 249, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 9; that said ditch is owned by Joel F. Culver and William C. Barnes; that said ditch takes its water from the East side of said Oak Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of four and one half (4.5) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owners, under and by virtue of priority No. 249, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said four and one half acres of land.
