

during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said thirty acres of land.

No. 293—The Smith Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 251, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 10; that said ditch is owned by Joel S. Culver and William C. Barnes; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on the West side of said Oak Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twelve (12) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 251, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said twelve acres of land.

No. 294—The Middle Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 252, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 71, and Brush Creek priority No. 27, and South Brush Creek priority No. 11; that said ditch is owned by I. N. Fellows; that said ditch takes its water from the South side of South Brush Creek at a point whence the S. $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Sec. 22, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East bears S. 73 degrees and 44 minutes West, 971 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 14 acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 252, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said 14 acres of land.
