

53 degrees and 5 minutes from the N. W. corner of the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 25, Tp. 20 S, R 71 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-five (35) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 258, constantly during the irrigation season, one and two tenths (1.2) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 338, the further quantity of two (0.2) tenths of one cubic foot of water per second of time, which said amount of water shall also be allowed to flow constantly during the irrigation season.

#### No. 299—The Griffin Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 259, 350 and 359, which are also Oak Creek priorities 12, 21 and 23; that said ditch is owned by George W. Griffin; that the head of said ditch is situate on the West side of Oak Creek at a point 450 feet S. 74 degrees and 8 minutes E. from the N. E corner of the S. E quarter of Sec. 26, Tp. 20 S, R 71 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Griffin, under and by virtue of priority No. 259, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of three (3) acres of land; that said amount of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 350, for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of three (3) additional acres of land; and that said amount of water be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No.
