

359, for such still further time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of four (4) acres of still additional land.

**No. 300—The Amy South Ditch.**

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 260, which is also Howard Creek priority No. 10; that said ditch is owned by S. M. Amy; that said ditch takes water from Howard Creek, and its head is situate at a point on the South side of said creek, 295 feet distant from the eighth corner next South of the center of Sec. 5, Tp. 48 N, R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, for the use of said Amy, under and by virtue of said priority No. 260, two (2) cubic feet of water per second of time.

**No. 301—The Park Ditch.**

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 262, which is also Beaver Creek priority No. 41; that said ditch is owned by John W. Gribble and S. J. Mulock, each of whom owns an undivided half thereof; that said ditch takes its water from Beaver Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred (100) acres of land owned by said Gribble and fifty-five (55) acres owned by said Mulock; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, for the use and benefit of said owners, under and by virtue of said priority No. 262, six and two tenths (6.2) cubic feet of water per second of time.
