

for the use and benefit of said Kaess, under and by virtue of priority No. 269, one and fifty-two hundredths (1.52) cubic feet of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of fourteen acres of land; that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the irrigation of twenty-four (24) acres of land owned by said Eggleston under and by virtue of priority No. 294, for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said 24 acres of land; that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Eggleston, under and by virtue of priority No. 361 the additional quantity of seventy-six hundredths of one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of seven (7) acres of land; that said seventy-six hundredths of one cubic foot of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Kaess, under and by virtue of priority No. 399, for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of eight (8) acres of land; and that said quantity of seventy-six hundredths of one cubic foot of water per second of time be still further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Eggleston, under and by virtue of priority No. 406, for such still additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of four (4) acres of land; the total quantity of water decreed this ditch being two and twenty-eight (2.28) cubic feet of water per second of time.
