

of priority No. 291; for such additional time and times as shall be sufficient for the irrigation of fifty-five (55) acres of land; that the rights of this ditch are not, in any manner, subject or subordinate to the rights of The Pauls Ditch, The Home Ditch and The Mineral Creek Ditch, which are taken from Mineral Creek above the junction with Adobe Creek.

No. 310—The Woods Pasture Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 273, 358 and 391, which are also Stout Creek priorities No's 14, 17 and 21; that Isabelle N. Veal owns one half of said ditch and George W. Jackson the other half; that said ditch takes its supply of water from said Stout Creek, and its head-gate is situate at a point on the North bank thereof from which the joint corner of Sections 22, 23, 26 and 27, Tp. 48 N, R 10 E, bears N 69 degrees and 30 minutes E, 2200 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fourteen and one half (14.5) acres owned by said Veal and seventeen (17) acres owned by said Jackson; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the irrigation of ten acres owned by said Jackson and twelve acres owned by said Veal, under and by virtue of priority No. 273, one and twenty-six hundredths (1.26) cubic feet of water per second of time for and during such time and times as necessary for the irrigation of twenty-two (22) acres of land; that said amount of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Veal, under and by virtue of priority No. 358, for such additional time and times as is sufficient to irrigate two and one half acres of land; and that said quantity of water be still further al-
