

lowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Jackson, under and by virtue of priority No. 391, for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of seven acres of land.

No. 311—The Phelps Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority Nos 273, and 399; that said ditch is owned by John S. Logan; that said ditch takes water from said Arkansas River at a point on the South side thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirteen (13) acres of land and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Logan, under and by virtue of priority No. 273, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of eight (8) acres of land; and that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 399, for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land.

No. 312—The Cuddy Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 276, which is also Howard Creek priority No. 12; that said ditch is owned by E. V. Amy and S. M. Amy; that said ditch takes water from said Howard Creek, at a point 275 feet from the eighth corner next South of the center of section 5, Tp. 48 N, R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty (50) acres of land; and that there be allowed to run in said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, under and by virtue of said priority No. 276, for the use of the said owners of said ditch, two (2) cubic feet of water per second of time.
