

lowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 401, for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; and that said cubic foot of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 407, for and during such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of twenty acres of land.

No. 315—The Bragg Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 270, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 14; that said ditch is owned by Martin McCormick; that the head of said ditch is situate on the West side of Oak Creek, in Section 18, Tp. 21 S, R 70 West, County of Custer; and that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 280, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said ten acres of land.

No. 316—The Sampson Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No. 280 and 347, which are also Cottonwood Creek priorities No's 17 and 19; that said ditch is owned by J. T. Sampson; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of land; that said ditch is 15 inches wide at the top, ten inches wide at the bottom, nine inches deep and has a grade of three quarters of an inch to the rod; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 280, such an amount of water as said ditch will carry for as many periods,
