

ditch is situate on the North bank of said Brush Creek; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 292, one and eighty-four hundredths (1.84) cubic feet of water per second of time.

#### No. 324—The Bridge No. 3 Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 293; that said ditch is owned by Amasa W. Lucas; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-five (25) acres of land; that its headgate is at a point on the south side of the Arkansas River 2658 feet distant from the common corner of sections 17, 18, 19 and 20, Tp. 19 S, R 68 West; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, for the use and benefit of said Lucas, under and by virtue of said priority, one cubic foot of water per second of time.

(Note: Point of diversion changed to headgate of the Portland Ditch by decree of May 9th, 1904, recorded in Book 13 Page 373.)

#### No. 325—The Coffin Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 295, 318 and 386, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 84, 87 and 107, and Brush Creek priorities No's 32, 45 and 35; that said ditch is owned by Levinalh Coffin; that the head of said ditch is situate on the South East bank of said Brush Creek at a point whence the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sec. 27, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East bears N. 34 degrees and 53 minutes West, 393 feet; that said ditch is
