

riority No. 305, which is also Bernard Creek priority No. 6; that said ditch is owned by O. B. Carroll; that said ditch takes its water from said Bernard Creek and its head is situate on the East side thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one and one quarter (1.25) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 303, one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said amount of land.

#### No. 328—The Riggs Ditch No. 3.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 304, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 66; that said ditch is owned by Julia S. Riggs; that said ditch takes its water from Bernard Creek, a tributary to said Four Mile Creek, and the location of said ditch is such that it is only subject to older priorities of the ditches heading in Fremont County; that its headgate is situate in the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 35, Tp. 14 S, R 70 West, in the County of El Paso; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-five (25) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 304, one cubic foot of water per second of time.

#### No. 329—The Sanders Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 306, which is also Hardscrabble Creek pri-
